## Learn more about the Birregurra water supply upgrade

Barwon Water is upgrading Birregurra's drinking water supply by constructing a new underground pipeline to connect Birregurra to the Colac water supply system. The upgrade will ensure we can continue to provide high quality, affordable and secure services for our existing customers, as well as cater for future growth. Construction is scheduled to commence in May 2023 and be completed by mid-2024. Works will take place along the pipeline alignment, between Forrest Street in Colac, and Bowden Street in Birregurra.

## Customer water usage

Now that Birregurra Sustainable Communities - Water project is in its third year, we're taking a closer look at water usage patterns and customer leaks. To date, the digital meter technology has helped identify small and large leaks at 23% of properties in Birregurra. Although the leaks have been repaired. 15 million litres of water has been lost to leaks since December 2020 when the meters were first installed. It has been wonderful to see that when customers are notified of a possible leak that they act on in quickly. Since January 2021, 89 leaks have been repaired. This has saved Birregurra customers approximately \$81,000 on water bills and around 38 million litres of water if they were left unrepaired for a 12month period! If you are notified of a leak and you can't find or fix it, contact a licensed plumber or if you're renting. contact your landlord or agent. Barwon Water also has a range of support and plumbing assistance programs to help with leaks so if you're unsure where to start, contact us on 1300 656 007 or email info@barwonwater.vic.gov.au.
