As the weather warms up, we're continuing to reach out and support customers with leaks and/or higher than usual water usage. It's estimated that 9% of water use can be attributed to undetected leaks so it's important to check for leaks regularly – even a small leak can lead to a higher than usual water bill if left unrepaired. And remember, we have a variety of support programs available to assist with leaks, so please reach out if you'd like some help.

Waterwise tips for summer

We expect water usage to increase in Birregurra over the summer months with people enjoying spending more time outdoors and in their backyards with family and friends. We want you to enjoy your time outdoors, but it's important to be mindful of your water use to help conserve water and protect our local environment. If you have a backyard pool or spa, having a pool cover or blanket is an essential accessory. An uncovered pool can lose up to 55,000 litres of water a year through evaporation. A pool cover can reduce evaporation by up to 97% and keep the water warm until you're ready to take a dip. Covers are also an easy and effective way to keep the bugs and garden debris out, which means less cleaning, and a cover will also help keep energy bills lower. If you have a fountain or water feature at your home, make sure it recirculates the water (almost all of them do) and use a broom instead of a hose to keep paved areas and hard surfaces clean.
